Dear Ambassador,

In the letter referred to above, on 25 October 2010 a call for contributions was launched to Member/Contributing States for personnel to be seconded to the European Union Police Mission in Afghanistan (EUPOL AFGHANISTAN). Subject to the adoption of the Council Decision extending the Mission mandate and approving the appropriate Financial Statement, the duration of the deployment should be of 12 months.

I kindly draw your attention to the fact that all personnel-related costs for secondment are the responsibility of the Member State, including salaries, medical coverage, travel expenses to and from the Mission area (including home leave) and allowances other than those paid according to Council document 7291/09 (10 March 2009).

I also draw your attention to the fact that selected personnel will have to possess the security clearance at the level of EU SECRET and present all other documents referred to in Annex 1 of the letter referred to above (Essential Requirements and Job Descriptions).

In addition, for administrative purposes, kindly send us the attached form confirming the medical fitness, the security clearance and the duration of the deployment.
